Overview

The global water management programme is aimed to attract the best and most senior managers from across the globe within the water sector.

The programme will last approximately 2 months and has international recognition from the Chartered Management Institute.

All candidates who attend this programme and complete the assessments will receive up to 12 certificates of recognition, CMI membership and come out with Foundation Chartered Status (fCMgr) with the opportunity to progress to full Char- tered Manager status (CMgr). The programme will be delivered over a period of two months, with 6 days in RIyadh and another 6 days in London. The attendees will also be given time to complete the online CMI bite size programmes. To obtain certification and chartered status candidates must complete all the online bite size programmes and if they want to become fully chartered then they must complete the relevant assessment. The programme also includes experts in the water sector who will present on current challenges and opportunities.

Who will be attending these workshops?

It is proposed that these workshops are aimed at senior management within the water sector. To qualify for these workshops the attendee would need to at least have one indi- vidual directly reporting to them but also possess the right kind of seniori- ty to get the most out of these work- shops. There will be a pre-assess- ment done by us in order to deter- mine who will qualify. The prerequi- sites required line managebe responsibility, at least 5 vears strategic management experience and must be working in the water sector.
